At seven miles wide, finding fresh tracks is as easy as finding elbow room. In fact, on an average day, there are only two skiers per acre, and on a busy day, only four!

Vail receives an average of 346 Inches of snow each winter and combined with 300 days of sunshine a year and you've got perfect conditions. With seven colossal bowls, tons of cliffs



and a grip of secret stashes and hits, the entire mountain is a playground.
