# Interlaken Means between Two Lakes

As of press time, there are 30 people heading out to Switzerland on January 21 though January 29. Some international travel things to remember: 1) Always have your passport; if you get thrown in a foreign jail, I'm not coming to get you out. 2) Europe has different power outlets than in the U.S. You can buy a converter for \$10-20 at a Radio Shack or like store. 3) It's best to use your ATM card instead of the currency exchange (but the exchange rate sucks regardless of how you look at it). 4) Herren is the German word for men and damen means women – so you have no excuse for being in the wrong bathroom. 5) The official languages of Switzerland are German and French. We will be in the German-speaking area for the most part. Most people speak English, but it's best to learn a few words and phrases. Examples as follows:

Danke (schoen) = thank you (very much)  
 Bitte = please, you're welcome  
 (guten) tag = hello  
 Auf weidersehen = good-bye (see ya later)  
 See the reference to herren and damen above  
 Bier = beer  
 Let's get drunk = Lassen Sie uns betrunken erhalten

If people don't understand you – don't yell – they're not deaf, they just don't speak English very well. There are a few people in the group who do speak German and I'm sure one of us will help you for a few bucks.

A representative from Outdoor Interlaken will be at our wine & cheese party on the first night to talk about side trips and other activities. Some of the "other activities" include tobogganing, cross-country skiing, sleigh rides, etc.

Per our resident ski instructor, Bill Hausmann, we will have lessons on day 2 or 3 so that you can't use the excuse of jet lag as being synonymous with poor ski technique.

# IBEX RACING

Racing is a great way to tune up your skiing, even though you are in the Midwest. Sometimes skiing in the Midwest is vertically disappointing, but racing offers some new challenges. By turning when you do not necessarily want to turn, you are forced to learn to be lighter on your skis and therefore a more proficient skier.

**People often feel that they have to be a good skier to race with CMSC. I can assure you that is not the case.**

CMSC breaks up the racers by gender, age, and skill set (including never evers). Therefore no previous experience is required. The courses are set for the specific race classes as well. So for the less experienced racers, the gates are set further apart, and for the more experienced racers; PSIA are followed. You can also meet people from many different ski clubs as this is a CMSC sponsored activity, so all clubs from the Chicago area participate, and some ski clubs from MI and WI also attend.

***If you have never raced, I encourage you to attend at least one race.***

## **Details on Family Night at Wilmot**

### Cost:

Discounted Lift Tickets will cost \$16.50. (Regular price is \$25) Payment is due at the time of sign-up. Lift tickets are good until 11:00 p.m.

- We need 20 people in order to get the discounted price. *Members and friends are welcome to come out and ski and ride with us. You don't have to sign up for a lesson to take advantage of the discounted tickets.*
- Children must at least 8 years of age and must be a relative of a member in order to take lessons.
- Waivers for minors will be available at the meetings in December and January. Waivers must be signed by a parent and the relative accompanying the child on the trip.

## Renting equipment:

- If you are renting equipment plan to arrive by 3:30 p.m. Rentals are an additional cost. \$10 extra for skis, boots and poles and \$20 extra for snowboards and boots. Security deposits will be required:
- Each person renting ski equipment is required to leave a \$10.00 cash deposit and I.D.
- Snowboard and Boot deposit is \$100.00 cash, VISA, MC, AE, DIS.
- Drivers license or photo I.D. also required for snowboard equipment rental.
- **Wilmot Ski Rental Packages include LOOK bindings, easy entry boots, and poles.**

## After Lessons:

We will meet in the BAR, located in the middle of the main lodge, where we will order pizzas and snacks for dinner. (Brown bagging is acceptable!)
